### **Personal Statement (in his words)**

### **Work Overview (in his words)**

In September 2014 I returned back home from teaching English in schools in India and realised my potential for working with young people. Since then, I have worked with young people in a variety of capacities. In my two years as an outdoor education instructor, I became very confident in leading all of the activities. The wide range of children who arrived at the outdoor education centre was very refreshing and it has helped me adapt the way I teach based on the children I have in front of me. I left the outdoor education centre because I wanted to find a role which allowed me to build a rapport with children over a longer period of time so I could have more of an impact on their lives. I started working with disadvantaged children in London while also pursuing my passion for coaching sport as a swimming teacher. These two positions fit alongside my first role as a male nanny, and in September 2016 I moved into my first live-in role looking after two boys aged 9 and 11. A year later In September 2017, I decided to take my work abroad. I have since worked as a nanny and swimming teacher in Australia and as a holiday nanny in Indonesia. All of these roles included looking after children aged three and above. My previous nanny roles have included working with children who have Autism, ADHD and behavioural problems. In late June 2018, I arrived back in England and started working as an outdoor education instructor at the centre I first started at. I'm currently working as a live-in nanny, England for two boys aged 7 and 8.

## **Work History (in his words)**

### **(November 2018 – Present) Live-In Nanny – Woking (Two boys aged 7 and 8)**

I'm currently working for a family of four in Woking, England. The boys are aged 7 and 8 and I'm responsible for them from when they wake up until they're asleep. This includes making dinners, organising homework and after-school clubs. I was brought into this position because the mum was recovering from surgery and had fallen ill. The position was initially until February however my contact has been extended until May 2019.

### **(June 2018 – October 2018) Seasonal Outdoor Education Instructor**

### **(May 2018 – June 2018) Holiday Nanny – Indonesia, Bali (Two boys aged 9 (Mild Autism) and 14)**

I was responsible for keeping both boys engaged in fun activities whilst away on holiday in Bali. I arranged all kinds of activities from playing in water parks and surfing to ATV riding and challenging escape rooms. I adapted my style to fit with their different ages so they were engaged at all times. They enjoyed having someone sporty and active to look after them.

### **(April 2018 – May 2018) Proxy Parent – Melbourne (boy aged 5 and girl aged 8)**

This was a short-term proxy parent role while both parents travelled away for work. Unfortunately, before I moved into the position the children's parents split up and moved to different houses. I was responsible for supporting the children over this difficult time and looking after them when both of their parents were out of the state.

### **(October 2017 – April 2018) Swim Teacher – (Carlton Baths)**

### **(September 2017 – April 2018) Au Pair/Live-In Nanny – Melbourne (Two boys aged 8 and 10)**

This was a fantastic nanny role which only ended because of the visa requirements in Australia. I was responsible for the boy's day to day lives from waking them up in the morning to dinner in the evening. I created a clear structure which the children responded well to and I built up a rapport with them focused around the word trust. The boys understood my firm but fair boundaries and woke up every morning ready for school so they could go outside and play cricket/football!

### **(June 2017 – August 2017) Live-In Holiday Nanny – London (Two boys aged 8 and 10)**

This was a temporary nanny position over the English summer holidays looking after two boys aged 8 and 10. The role included helping with 'Kumon' which is a Maths and English study programme, every morning. The boys and I visited different attractions in London and participated in many different sports over the summer holidays. I kept them engaged through different activities while also keeping a plan and routine to help them feel comfortable.

I worked as a nanny for this family during the school year. At the time I also worked as a swimming teacher on the weekends and for an education charity in London while the kids were at school. I was responsible for the boys' breakfast and dinner. As well as all other normal nanny duties (bedrooms, bed sheets) etc. I focused on the children becoming more independent and being responsible for themselves. I built up a great rapport with the boys and their close friends. The family decided they no longer needed a nanny at the end of the school year.

We use those outdoor activities to focus on soft skills such as teamwork, communication and trust. We may also run small expeditions for older groups.
